PROHIBITED ITEMS

South Kent Landfill, North Kent Transfer Station, Kent County Waste to Energy

Kent County staff reserve the right to reject total or partial loads that are deemed unacceptable. Unacceptable waste in concentrations or quantities that, in the sole judgment of Kent County, would pose a substantial threat to public health or safety; cause applicable air quality or water effluent standards to be violated by the normal operation of the Facility; or have a reasonable possibility of adversely affecting the operation of the Facility will be rejected.

Unacceptable waste includes but is not limited to:

- Explosives: dynamite, hand grenades, blasting caps, ammunition, volatile gases/liquids, any other explosives
- Liquid Wastes (as defined by [Michigan Department of Environmental Quality](#)) - includes septage and untreated sewage
- Pathological or Biological Waste (as defined by [Michigan Department of Environmental Quality](#))
- Radioactive Waste
- Yard Clippings (as defined by [Michigan Department of Environmental Quality](#))
- Asbestos
- Polychlorinated Biphenyls (PCBs)
- Motor Oil
- Sealed Drums
- Beverage Containers (as defined by [Michigan Department of Environmental Quality](#))
- Hazardous Waste (as defined under [Federal, State and Local laws and regulations](#))
- Lead Acid Batteries*
- Whole motor vehicle tires*
- Propane tanks*
- Freon and other refrigerants*

*Items with this indicator are prohibited from being disposed as mixed waste but are accepted separately at the North Kent Transfer Station and South Kent Landfill. Additional disposal fees may apply.

Artículos Prohibidos

South Kent Landfill, North Kent Transfer Station, Kent County Waste to Energy

Los empleados de Kent County reservan el derecho de rechazar por total o parcial cargas que se consideran inaceptables. Residuos inaceptables en concentraciones o cantidades que, a juicio exclusivo de Kent County, representaría una amenaza considerable para la salud o la seguridad pública; que causan que la de calidad del aire o normas de efluentes de agua sean violado por la operación normal de la Planta; o que tenga una posibilidad razonable de afectar de manera adversa el funcionamiento de la planta será rechazada.

Residuos inaceptables incluyen, pero no son limitados a los siguientes:

- Explosivos: dinamita, granadas de mano, detonadores, munición, gases/líquidos volátiles, cualquier tipo de explosivo
- Los desechos líquidos (como definido por [Michigan Department of Environmental Quality](#)) - incluye residuos sépticos y aguas residuales
- Basura radiactiva
- Desechos de jardín (como definido por [Michigan Department of Environmental Quality](#))
- Asbestos
- Los bifenilos policlorados
- Aceite de motor
- Barriles sellados
- Contenedores de bebidas (como definido por ([Michigan Department of Environmental Quality](#)))
- Residuos peligrosos (como definido por [Federal, State and Local laws and regulations](#))
- Baterías que contienen ácido de plomo*
- Llantas enteras de vehículos *
- Tanques de propano*
- El freón y otros refrigerantes*

* Es prohibido desechar estos objetos pero son aceptadas individualmente en el North Kent Transfer Station y South Kent Landfill. Cargos adicionales pueden ser aplicados.
